## Definition - RoHS

The **Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (RoHS)** 2002/95/EC [1] was adopted in February 2003 by the [European Union](#). The **RoHS** directive took effect on July 1, 2006, but is not a law; it is simply a [directive](#). This directive restricts the use of six hazardous materials in the manufacture of various types of electronic and electrical equipment.



## Categories covered by RoHS

Section 3. IT and Telecommunications Equipment

Section three of the categories covered by **RoHS** is applicable for DMS WIRELESS telecommunications products.



## Compliance - RoHS
